- forming a 'think tank' for the future development of the universities of technology in Europe.

As an informal grouping the conference has no formal international or European organisational structure.

Discussions at the 2011 Conference will address issues such as:

- Integrating education, research and innovation at universities of technology and making the knowledge triangle a reality
- Safeguarding the research orientation of universities of technology
- How to utilize research for enriching education and stimulating student learning
- From teacher centered engineering education towards approaches facilitating learning by integrating research activities
- How to link research and education with innovation through close cooperation and interaction with industry
- First experiences from EIT Knowledge and Innovation Centers (KICs)
- Lessons learned from integrating students in research cooperation with industry
- Utilizing technology transfer centers, incubators, science and technology parks for education and training
- Other aspects as defined by speakers and participants.
