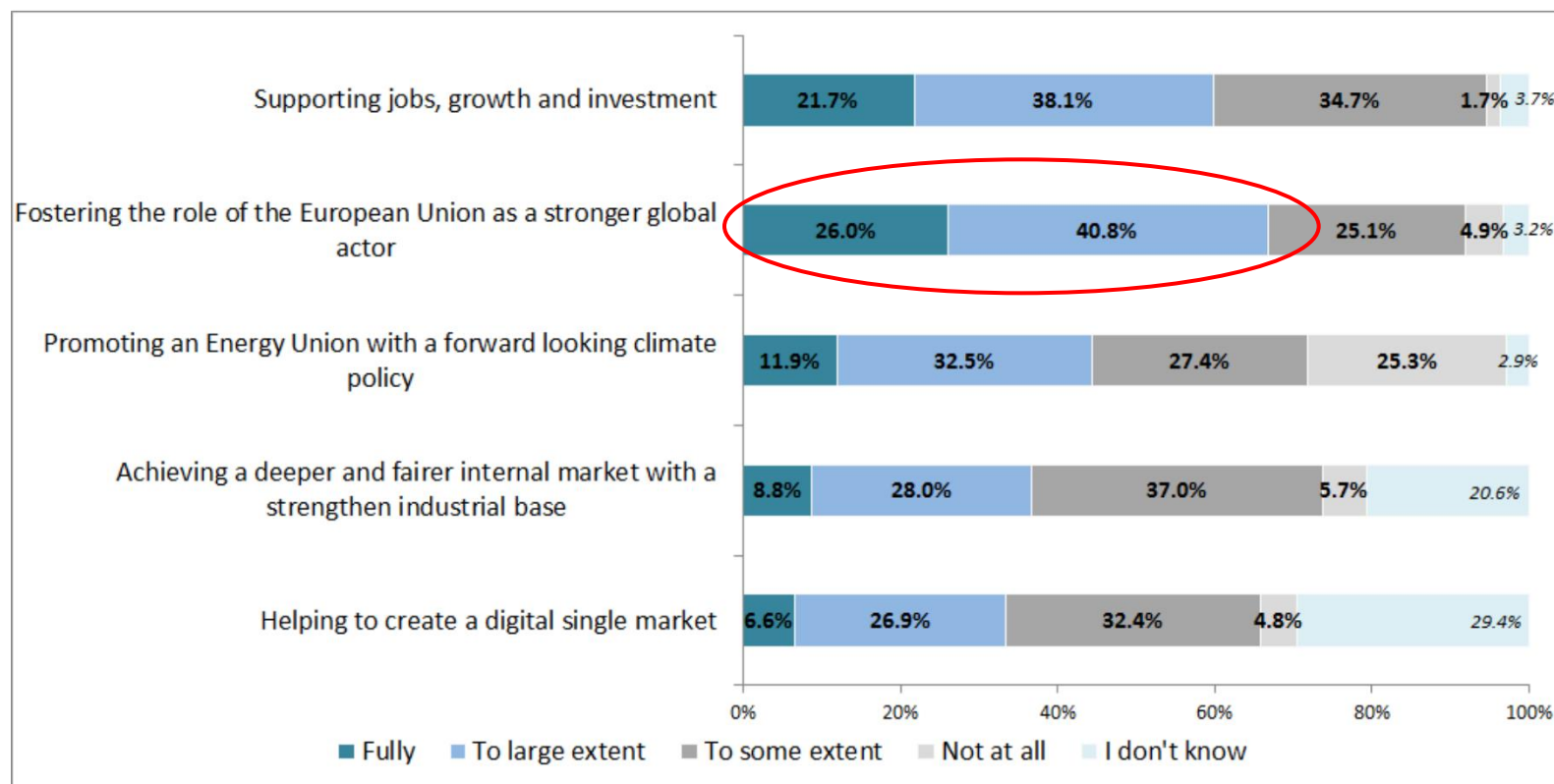

International Cooperation Strategy

Enhancing and focusing EU international cooperation in research and innovation



Strengthening excellence, attractiveness and competitiveness

- Fall in third country participations in collaborative Horizon 2020 projects: half of FP7
- Good international participation in ERC and MSCA actions: similar to FP7 level
- Improved framework conditions for international R&I cooperation: e.g. co-funding mechanisms; towards a 'Global Research Area'
- Corrective actions, notably Flagship Initiatives in Horizon 2020 Work Programme 2018-20
 - Based on policy dialogues & roadmaps for cooperation with international partners
 - Initiatives of large scale and scope on topics dedicated to international cooperation
