- Member of Sorbonne University Alliance
- Located 40min north of Paris
- 4400 students, 800 full time staff (thereof 390 faculty)
- Large range of education and research: Computer science, mechanical engineering, biomechanics and bioengineering, cellular and enzyme engineering, urban systems engineering, chemical engineering, humanities applied to research
- International focus with mandatory student mobility, strategic partners and strong promotion of French scientific language


