
- 1. Values in Design

Values hierarchy

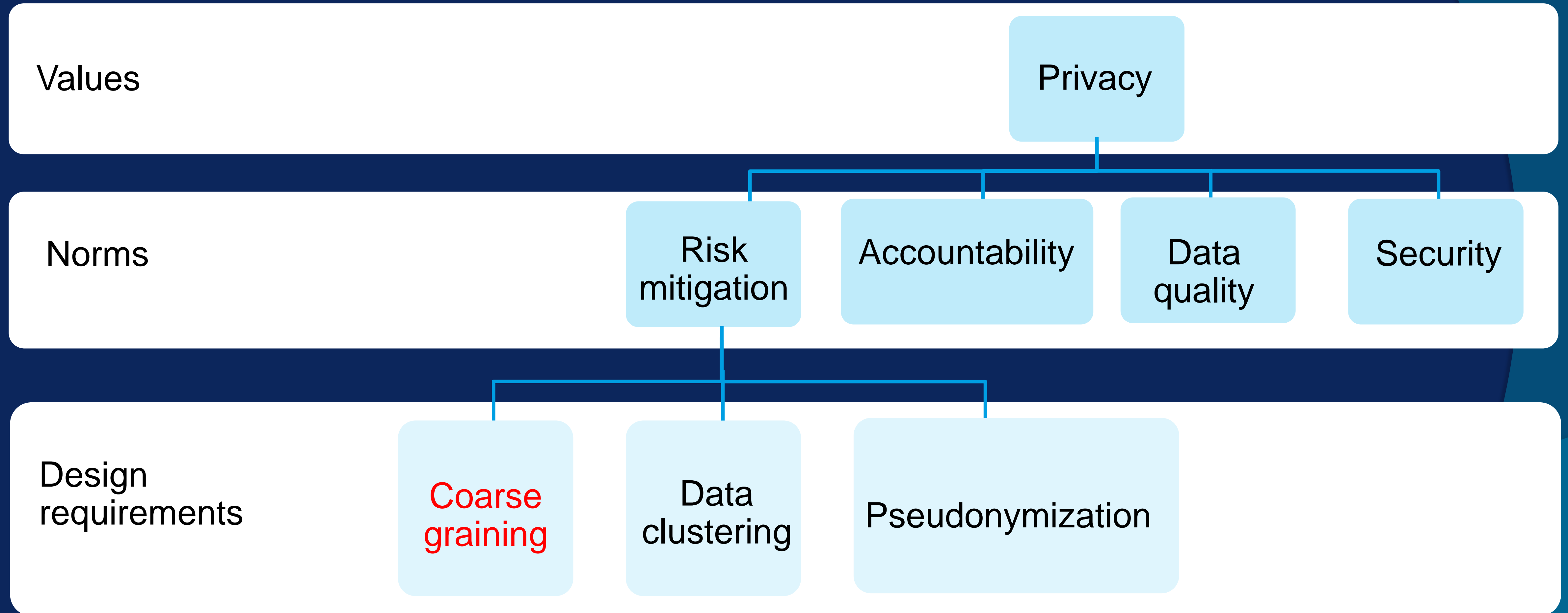


High-level

Example of a value hierarchy





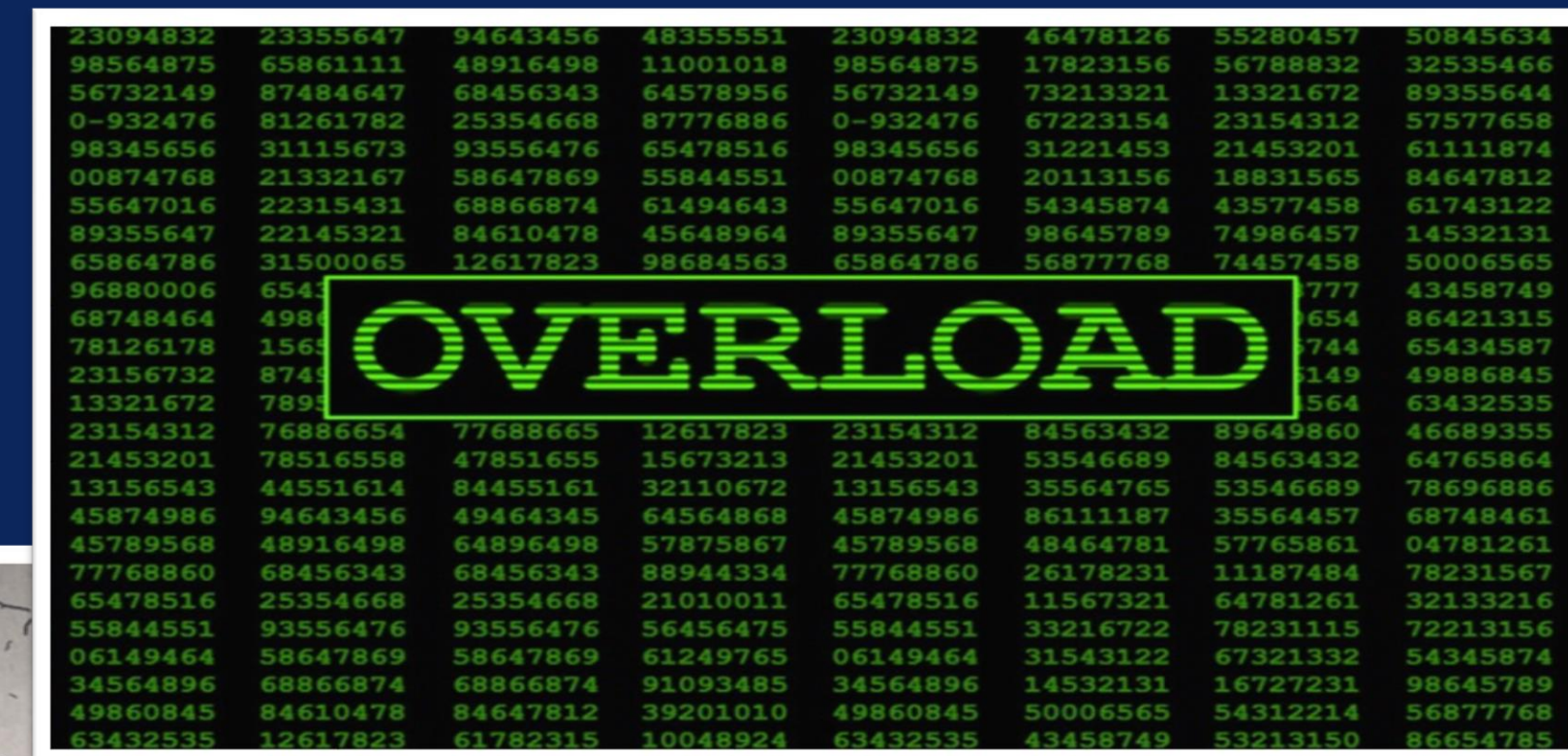

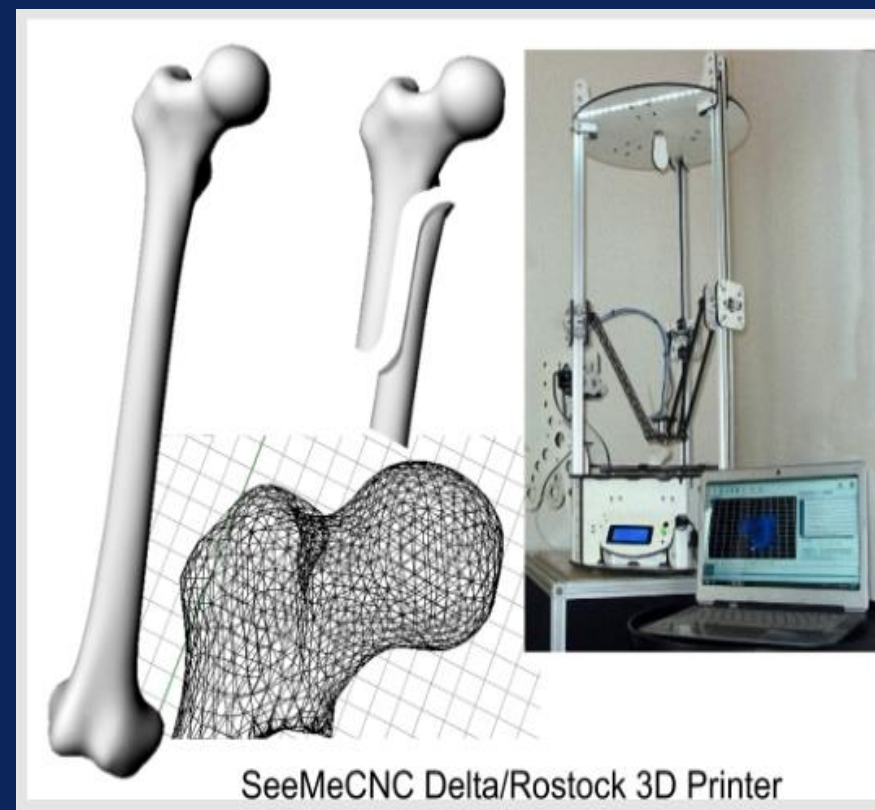
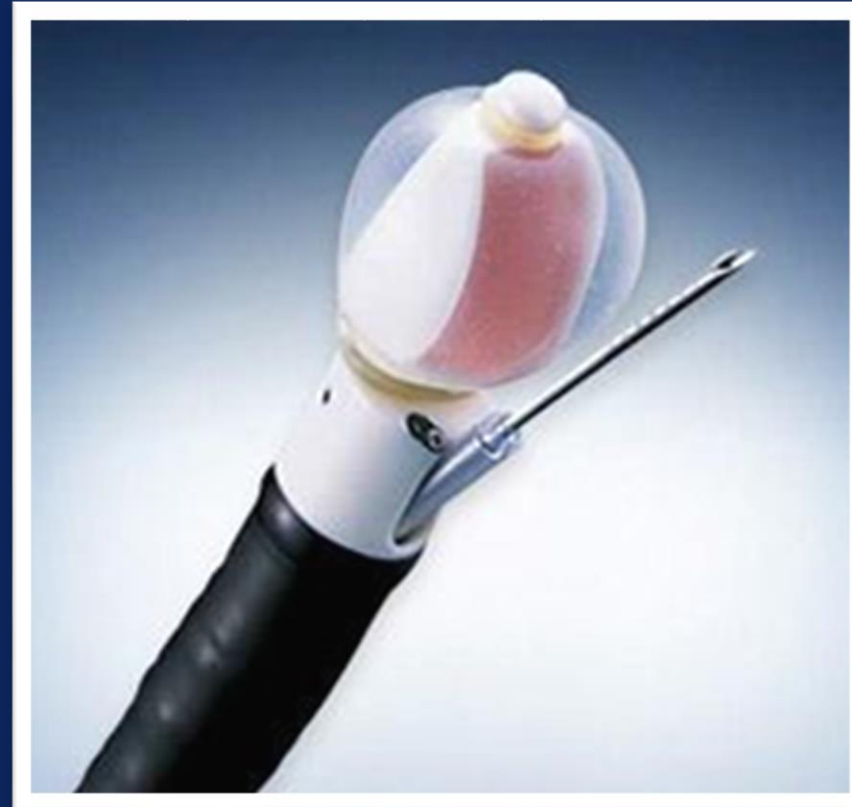
