Invitation to the 2022 Conference at TU Wien

Dear colleague,

We cordially invite you to crp2022, the 40th Conference of Rectors and Presidents of European Universities of Technology.

The pandemic confronted all universities with emergencies that required urgent adaptation of teaching, research and innovation to the new situation. The problems faced during the pandemic and the experiences made are stimulating universities to review their specific missions and long-term strategies. Universities of technology in particular need to find appropriate sustainable solutions for economic, social and environmental development. Global challenges such as climate change and the green transition, digitisation and artificial intelligence, and others call for comprehensive approaches for teaching and learning, research and innovation, and societal outreach. Cooperation across disciplinary boundaries and co-development with external agents and users require appropriate institutional structures and adequate processes and procedures. In addition, the digital transition will need fundamental reconsiderations of university management and academic activities.

Keynote speakers will discuss the Conference topic from different perspectives and leaders of European Universities of Technology will present their institutions' future oriented missions, plans, strategies and initiatives.

General background of the conference:

Following a joint initiative of the rectors of Vienna University of Technology and RWTH Aachen University, this conference started in 1980 with the aim of establishing an informal platform for top representatives of leading science and engineering universities in Europe for:

- Discussing topics of major common concern, that are not discussed in other fora,
- identifying differences and commonalities of existing solutions to problems of common interest,
- developing new ideas and if appropriate preparing recommendations on specific topics, and
- forming a 'think tank' for the future development of the universities of technology in Europe.

As an informal grouping, the conference has no formal international or European organisational structure.

Discussions at the 20221 Conference will address issues such as:

The conference topic will give an opportunity to discuss different aspects of universities' perspectives, plans and strategies, regarding the specific roles and functions of universities of technology, such as:

- Vision and mission of universities of technology in post-pandemic times and in the long-term
- Coping with the climate and digital transition through appropriate strategies, structures and procedures
- Contributing to sustainable development through balancing education and learning, research and development, innovation and entrepreneurship, outreach and societal impact
- Involving and including society beyond fostering public understanding of science and technology future developments on the basis of lessons learnt from the pandemic
- Providing evidence and advice on science, technology and innovation issues
- Supporting equal opportunities gender equality and diversity accessibility attracting talent from all parts of society independently of gender, religion, and ethnic background
- Ensuring staff development opportunities including offering an advanced spectrum of academic career paths including the professionalisation of scientific support staff
- Strengthening internationalisation European and global positioning, cooperation, and competition combining connectivity and physical mobility
